

IN BROAD DAYLIGHT.

VERDICT AGAINST ST. ALBANS

SYDNEY, July 5.
Reserved judgment was delivered today in the action brought by the United States Shipping Beard, as owners
of the motor ship Crown City, 5426tons, against the Eastern and Australian Steamship Company, owners of
the steamer St. Albans, 4119 tons, alleging negligence and claiming 417,000
recompense for damages suffered by
the Crown City in a collision in Sydney
Harbour on October 22 last. Both
vessels were extensively damaged.

THE FINDING

Chief Justice Street found the St. Albans in fault, directed an inquiry before the Registrar to ascertain the amount of damage suffered by the Crown City, and ordered the St. Albans to pay the amount ascertained, with the costs of the action. He expressed surprise that such a collision could have occurred in broad daylight. A stay of proceedings was granted.
