## **Cover of the quarter**

Manchester Additional ½ letter, 1839



Crossing the Pennines when it was possible to pick up the London to Edinburgh mail coach in York, seems an unlikely move.

However, this letter **from Leeds** has travelled on one of the twice daily mail coaches to **Manchester**, taking 5 ½ hours for the 47mile trip, where the Additional ½ mark, M 155a was applied.

From there the letter was taken to **Warrington** on the **Grand Junction Railway** and then on to **Preston**, via an extension of the **North Union Railway**, which had opened on 7<sup>th</sup> November 1838. Transfer to a mail coach then completed the journey.

Postage was 1/1 because of the added mileage having travelled to Manchester.


